## ABOUT

### SCHNEEFERNERHAUS

Germany's highest environmental research station is located at an altitude of 2650 meters just below the peak of the Zugspitze in a high alpine setting. This comes with some particularities. Therefore, we kindly ask you to take note of the following guidelines.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### SECURITY

- Please take into account ongoing measurements as well as the measuring instruments.
- There is a ban on smoking on the terraces.
- Due to the altitude, there is a low oxygen content and air pressure.
- Medical emergency care may only be possible after 60 to 120 minutes.
- The instructions of the UFS operating personnel must be followed without exception.



#### Forscherbahn

The Schneefernerhaus must be vacated by 4:00 PM. Please note the maximum number of 8 persons (per ride) and plan your departure accordingly.



#### UV Radiation

The UV radiation is stronger at nearly 3,000 m than in the valley. Therefore, we recommend sunscreen with SPF 30 or 50.



#### Drinks

Please remember to bring enough drinks and snacks.



#### Clothing & Equipment

Depending on the temperature: sturdy footwear, gloves, headgear, sunglasses.

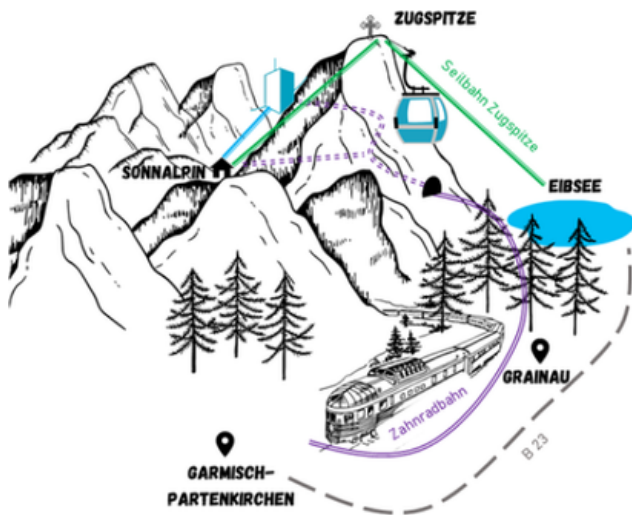

### ARRIVAL



### LUGGAGE

Luggage that exceeds a carry-on and a backpack (so-called hand freight) must be registered with UFS at least 24 hours in advance.

Costs will be incurred. The transportation of materials via the Bavarian Zugspitze Railway is charged per kilogram.

### PARKING

Please note the parking conditions at Eibsee and other stops of the cogwheel train. Parking at Eibsee costs €5.00 in winter and €11.00 per day/night in summer for guests of the UFS. Be careful with multi-day stays!

Please also contact the parking attendants on-site.

### ACCESS TO THE FORSCHERBAHN

The special UFS ticket from BZB entitles you to enter our valley station. Here, next to the monitor, you will find a hands-free intercom system.

The UFS ticket does **not** grant access to the lift facilities on the Zugspitzplatt. A separate lift ticket is required for this.

**Attention! There is a deposit of €2.00 on each ticket. Please have it ready at the cash register!**

Please note: The latest arrival at the UFS is at **3:00 PM**. A later arrival is not possible.

**There are no hiking trails to the Schneefernerhaus - alpine terrain (avalanche and rockfall danger).**
